Special Conditions of Sale

1. The property is sold subject to The Law Society's Conditions of Sale 1953 (hereinafter referred to individually by the designation "General Condition" together with the number thereof), so far as they are not varied by or inconsistent with these Conditions.

2. The Vendor's Solicitors are Messrs. Bailey & Co. whose office is at 30 Welbeck Street London W.1.

3. A deposit of $\pounds 10$ per cent on the amount of the purchase money shall be paid to the Auctioneers as Stakeholders.

4. The date fixed for completion is on or before the 29th day of September 1957.

5. The property is sold with vacant possession of Folly Cottage (part of Lot 1) and No. 6 Folly Cottages (part of Lot 2). The property is otherwise sold subject to the existing tenancies which are referred to in the Particulars and the rights and claims of tenants by contract statute or otherwise.

6. The Vendor is selling as Beneficial Owner.

7. The Title shall commence as to the greater part of Lot 1 (comprising "Folly Cottage") with a Conveyance on Sale dated the 16th day of January 1925 and as to the lesser part of Lot 1 (comprising "The Folly" and "Haycroft") with a Conveyance on Sale dated the 4th day of May 1929. As to the property Lot 2 (comprising 1-6 Folly Cottages) the title shall commence with a Conveyance on Sale dated the 2nd day of October 1933, and in every case the respective deeds with which it is above stipulated that the title to the respective parts of the property shall commence shall be accepted as good roots of title. 9. Lot 2 is sold subject to any requirement or proposal made or contemplated by or on behalf of any local or public authority whether under Section 11 of the Housing Act 1936 or othe wise, and General Condition 20(1) and (3) shall not apply to the property comprised in this Lot.

10. General Condition 35 shall have effect in substitution for General Condition 34.
