 pounds of like Lawfull money To be paid at such time as it shall be
 attain to the age of one and Twenty years Item I doe give devise
 and bequeath unto my daughter Elizabeth Kingfull Ten pounds
 and to her two Children Christopher and Mary five pounds a part
 of like Lawfull money To be likewise paid unto them within one
 year next after my decease Item I doe give devise and bequeath
 unto my loving wife Anne Robinson also Hunt the full sume of Twenty
 and possession of my dwelling house wherein I now dwell in full possession
 aforesaid with all the lands and appurtenances thereto belonging for
 and during the Term of her naturall life She paying yearly and every
 year to my said Grandchild William Robinson also Hunt the sume of

 pounds of good and Lawfull money of England by halfe yearly paymen
 And from and immediately after the decease of my said wife (in case my

 all my household goods which doe belong to the Room of my dwelling house
