The Will of God Mien

I William Hughes the elder of Tuxton in the County of Berks.
 You man being something weak of body but of sound and perfect
 mind and memory praise be thorofoe given to Almighty God for
 the same do make and ordain this my present last will and
 Testament in manner and form following (that is to say) first and
 principally I command my soul into the hands of Almighty God
 hoping through the merits death and passion of my Saviour Jesus
 Christ to have full and free pardon and forgiveness of all my sins
 and to inherit everlasting life And my body I commit to the Earth
 to be decently buried at the discretion of my Executors hereafter
 named first I will that my debts and funeral charges shall be paid
 and discharged I give and bequeath unto my eldest son
 William Hughes my lands or Estate called Copy holes of Tuxton
 situated lying and being in the parish of East伍dhay in the County
 of Berks and every part and parcel thereof And also I do
 give and bequeath unto this my son William my chief rent or
 footfarm rent of three pounds six shillings and eight pence payable
 yearly out of the manor of Westholme or Brightholme in the
 County of Berks And in case the said William Hughes shall
 happen to depart this life without issue of his body lawfully a
 begotten from the same Estate to be equally divided between the
 other two & scotiers or their heirs from I give and bequeath unto
 my second son John Hughes my Tenement or foothold Estate
 situated standing lying and being in the parish of Tuxton in the
 County of Berks and every part and parcel thereof And in case
 the said John Hughes shall happen to depart this life without
 issue of his body lawfully begotten from the same estate equally
 to descend and be divided between the other two & scotiers or
 their heirs from I give and bequeath unto my third or youngest
 son Thomas Hughes my chief rent or footfarm rent of eight pounds
 payable yearly out of Compton Beauchamp in the County of
 Berks And also I give and bequeath unto this my son Thomas
 my chief rent or footfarm rent of six pounds payable yearly out
 of the manor of Westford in the County of Berks And in case

the said Thomas Hughes shall happen to depart this life without issue
 of his body lawfully begotten then his auncienttents to be equally divided
 between the other two Brothers or their heirs Item I will that my son
 William Hughes shall and will yearly pay unto his Mother Barbara
 Hughes the sum of three pounds out of his Estate during her natural
 life for and towards her maintenance Item I will also that my son
 John Hughes shall pay unto his Mother Barbara Hughes the sum of one
 pound yearly out of his Estate during her natural life for and
 towards her maintenance Item I likewise will that my son Thomas
 Hughes shall and will yearly pay unto his Mother Barbara Hughes the
 sum of three pounds of good and lawfull money out of his Estate as
 during her natural life for and towards her maintenance Item I will
 and my meaning is that in case either of the said two others shall a
 happen to depart this life before their Mother and his Estate shewby
 fall between the other two Brothers as aforesaid yet my will is that the
 sum shall be paid to their Mother yearly and every year out of the said
 Estates during her life as is before mentioned Item I will that she shall have
 one upper Chamber for lodging and the use of the lower rooms and
 fine plate for necessary uses in my house in Sutton during her widowhood
 only she may give and bequeath unto my son and loving wife Barbara
 Hughes all my personal estate goods and chattels whatsoever I have
 both within doors and without with this proviso notwithstanding
 that my debts and funeral charges shall be paid and discharged out
 of my stock of Cattle and in case the value of the said stock will not
 amount or reach so high as to discharge my said debts then my will
 and meaning is that my two sons shall and do equally a
 contribution to make up the same sum shewing and to be discharged
 and if it so happen that the value of my stock of Cattle do happen
 to exceed my debts then I will that my executors shall and may
 have the dispose of the overplus and also of all my household goods
 as she shall think fit and convenient And I do make my loving
 wife Barbara Hughes aforesaid full and whole Executrix of this my
 last will and Testament And moreover I do hereby revoke disannull
 and make void all former wills and Testaments by me heretofore
 made in witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand and seal
 this 23rd day of January in the ninth year of the reign of our
 Sovereign Lady Queen Anne over Great Britain & Ireland anno
 1710, 20th Augustus son, sealed and signed this sheet having the two
 sixpenny stamps in the presence of us, Humphrey Bentz Thomas
 Shattock Mr. Kingsmill,
