**In the name of God Amen** the ninth and twentieth  
day of October anno dom 1653 I William Garsard of Inglepen in the  
County of Gloucester being in sound and perfect memory I praise my God  
therefore but considering the frailty of my human nature and the infallible  
certainty of my mortality do make and ordaine this my last will and Testament  
in manner and form following first and principally I bequeath my soul to  
my almighty maker and redeemer my body I bequeath unto the care from  
whence it came to remain until the resurrection of the faithfull  
in Christ Jesus And for my lands leases and all my worldly goods my will  
and meaning is that they shall be and remain to such persons and to such a  
place, and in such manner as is hereafter in this my will expressed first  
whereas my loving father in law Robert Webb gent deced in his tent  
lent and cast unto my wife and diverse of my other Children did by his last  
will and Testament give and bequeath unto them the tent and profits  
of certain leases of certain Lands which he held of mine in Inglepen and  
made my wife opportunity of his last will and Testament it is my will that  
they should hold the same according to the tent intent and meaning of the  
said Robert Webb in the said will declared And whereas I have my self  
by certain leases granted some Estates in reversion for the better provision  
of some others of my Children It is my will that they should be also held  
and enjoyed accordingly without disturbance or interruption But whereas  
I have not as yett made any provision for my two youngest Children John  
and Bridget and my wife is now conceited with Child my will and  
meaning is and I do give and bequeath unto my son John Garsard my  
tentent in Inglepen with my mill and all the ground in the possession  
of Robert Smith and the rents and profits issuing out of the same for  
and during the naturall life of him the said John Garsard to the said  
John Garsard paying yearly unto my house the chittent summe of  
twenty shillings but my meaning is that the said Robert Smith shall hold  
and enjoy the same during his term therin paying his rents according  
to his Cottants from I give and bequeath unto my said daughter Bridget  
one tentent in Inglepen in the possession of Stephen Goldridge and one  
partell in Inglepen called Inwood in the possession of John Gryt to  
hold and enjoy the same from and immediately after the determination  
of the several Estates of the said Stephen Goldridge and John Gryt for  
and during the naturall life of her the said Bridget Garsard she paying the  
aforesaid yearly rents out of the same from I give unto the Child with which  
my wife is conceited if it shall please God to bring it living into the world  
my tenement in Inglepen in the possession of Evan Davies and Bryant Walls  
from and after the determination of the several Estates of the said Evan and  
Bryant for and during the naturall life of such Child as shall be born; and  
said Child paying also the chittent rents unto my house out of the same

All the rest of my lands tenements rents and Woods in Juxon I give and bequeath unto Dorothy my deere and louring wife and unto my louring brother in law Thomas Whistler of Saltaster and unto my louring kinsman John Gunter of Langeford yonge and Hugh Whistler of Harrowe Sloe by name and imediately after my decease for and during the full tyme of tenn years from thence forth fully to be reserued and ented for and towards the payment of my debts and the breeding up of my children and the waifing of them such greate portions as they in their distretions shall thinke fitting Item I give unto my said Brother Thomas Whistler and unto my said Kinsman John Gunter and Hugh Whistler to each of them tenn shillings to buy them a ringe in token of my remembrance all the rest of my goods and Chattells I give unto my said louring wife and unto my said louring brother in law and Kinsmen, in trust for the payment of my debts and good of my said Children being assured of theire loves that they will be ayding and assisting unto my wife therin And I do make and ordaine my said said wife and louring wife Dorothy Harward and my said Brother Harward and my said Brother Thomas Whistler and my said Kinsman John Gunter and Hugh Whistler the joint Executors and Executors of this my said last will and Testament In witness whereof I have raifed this my last will and testamēt consisting of two sheetes of paper fles together to be read and published and have hereunto set my hand and seal the day and year & first aboue written dighted sealed and published in the presence of Edw: Allerton Cor: m:d: Hugh Whistler witness:
