In the name of God Amen I Bridgetta Platt being in sick and weakly condition yet in sound and perfect memory praise Almighty God yet knowing my end to be at hand, is better to be prepared when my change shall come I do declare this my last Will and Testament in manner and forme following First I bequeath my soule to Almighty God and my blessed Saviour wherby hath redeemed itt with his blood And when my body shall lay in the dust untill the resurrection I wish my buriall to be private with Christian Ceremony onely without vaing shewes or Circumcy All for my last good and chattle and all my worldly estate my will and intencion is that they shall and maye be sent to persons and to such uses and in such manner as shall hereafter in this my will is expressed First for my lease of grace out of Barton Ham I bequeath to my loving kinsman Mr William Carrard of Aukpen in the County of North with all things to and comers unto and one Silver Candle for my money due to me from Stephen Brien in the hands of Margaret Hoise widow and her Sonne John being bound for itt the principall being Charles Hoise I bequeath to my Sonne John Gunter of Wyngesford with my beaded Silver bolle and all my booke wherby are left att my decease with my little scale Ring and three pence of old gold and the gold purse that is written on and three pence of old gold And to my Sonne Ferdinando Gunter I bequeath two long silver bolles the best of the flower And to my Sonne Christopher Gunter one silver bolle and one Ring with stone in itt with one Damask board cloth and one boyell of the same with one Diaper nap bord cloth and one pair of flay sycote and one pair of pillowbere of Holland And to my Sonne Robert Gunter I bequeath one little quilt sacke bolle and two silver spoone one long Diaper board cloth and one Diaper nap bord cloth and one Damask boiwell and one pair of flay sycote and one pair of Torbrum pillowbere And to my Sonne William Webb of Wandebred Martiall being my Sisters Sonne I bequeath one pair of flay sycote and one pair of Holland pillowbere one flack bed the best of the same and one feather bolster and one green shaggy Rugg and one white

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balking pan, and one little brass pan and one warming pan and one frying pan and one
 little gridiron, and my husband's gown, and my best shagg petticoat, and two long Normandy board
 cloths, and two Normandy square board cloths and six hemp towells and three worsted
 sheets and all my flay, yam, and flay, and yam, and one pair of pillowcases and one pair
 of hemp sheets and flower quays two white worsted and two black worsted six night worsted
 and flower ruffe, two plain and two laced one ould beaver hatt and my felt hatt, and
 all my cushion Capps and two dutch quays and all my black quays and black godde
 and three of my best Double and all my quays and my little Quilt and my little wooden
 bundle and one pair of iron doggs, five shovell and tongs and one pair of bellows and
 one bundle and one great chest And to my Daughter A farther bequeath my black iron
 murring gown and one bedsted and brass mortar and Pistle, E. One Carven w
 of woodsted storling and three black wrought quays and three worsted sheets and one
 little bundle Item A farther bequeath unto my Cousin William Baker of Hungerford
 one feather bed one feather bolster, and to his wife two quays and two worsted sheets
 A farther bequeath unto my Cousin Dorothy Smith, one pair of Canvas sheets and one
 pair of Lorkran pillowcases one hemp board cloth and one towell and my worst black
 gown and my working daye petticoat and one pair of green worsted stockings Item
 A farther bequeath unto my Cousin Susan Smith one pair of Canvas sheets and one
 hemp board cloth and one hemp towell Item A farther bequeath to Ellis Kalden of
 Kintbury, my great ould bedsted standing in my own bed chamber in Winchester and
 my prest standing in the outward Carret and one low chair if it be there and one high chair
 of leather, and the long table bord in the buttery and the my best flork bed that is not disposed
 of and one feather bolster and one of the better sort of Coloured coverlet and one white coverlet
 and one little and one pair of hemp sheets one board cloth one hemp towell and to his
 wife flower of my neckcloths and three quays and three worsted sheets and two Double Aprons
 Shufft farther bequeath to Anne Dore of Winchester one pair of Canvas sheets and one
 pair of Lorkran pillowcases, and two table cloths one long Canvas cloth, and one sheet
 cloth and one square board in the hall and one side table and one towell and one galle of my
 small barrelle Item two hand ruybord if movable and one pail, and my little green bedsted and
 one plain livery ruybord and one leather chair for Anne and one Ornaments prest
 standing in the little garret, and one table standing in the dressing room, and all my
 cartzen vessel, and three quays and three worsted sheets and three worsted cloths and three
 working daye Aprons and one pair of tongs and five shovell and one pair of iron doggs
 my bundle in the best chamber and all the rest myt the notes Item A farther bequeath
 unto Richard Ditch my horse my mersh vault and my cooler and my mantle Curran
 my great liver and the hony ponde due to me from Mr. Ferran and Mr. Chyliffe
 and my furniture if it may be taken up in my life tyme and one high chair of green and
 one low green chair, and one long table bord in the hall, And to good wife A. report
 jake that is in her house and one of my brooches and the waite that belong to the
 three quays and three worsted sheets Item A farther to Elizabeth Baylye of Hilt p
 two white worsted quays, and two other white quays and flower worsted sheets and flower
 neckcloths with stock and one new Double Smock and one handkercheif and two plain
 ruffe Item A farther bequeath to Mr. Allen, or the Minister that shall vicary my my
 Annuall Simon forty shillings and to the clark E. six shillings, and to the vicar of
 Kintbury five pounds, And to the vicar of Andreye six pounds And doe make my
 Cousin William Carrard sole Executor of this my last Will and Testament being
 written in three sheets of paper And in many places interlined, And have given
 sett my hand and seal the 16. Day, and part above written of the said
 Sign. and sealed in the presence of John Brinkenden, Esq. marke of Richard
 Huddinge the younger, Esq. marke of William Knight

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
